1. Heard learned Advocate appearing for applicant and learned AGP for respondent-State.

2. The applicant seeks permission to withdraw amount deposited by respondent-State in pursuance to Award passed by Reference Court, which has been confirmed by this Court with modification as to interest part, which is made payable from date of Award under Section 11 of Land Acquisition Act instead of date of possession as was directed by Reference Court.

3. Although respondent nos.4 and 5 were made party in Reference as well as Appeal, it is not discernible that they have been granted any share in compensation amount. The Reference itself was filed by applicant by making respondent nos.4 and 5 as respondents.



4. The learned Advocate appearing for applicant has further placed on record copy of consent given by Tulsabai Ramnath Jagdand/respondent no.5. The respondent no.4 is no more. Her death certificate is filed on record.

5. In that view of matter, there is no impediment in permitting withdrawal of amount alongwith accrued interest thereon.

6. In result, Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer Clauses (B) and (C).
