1. Learned Counsel for the Applicant, on instructions, makes statement that Applicant is ready to deposit a sum of Rs.1,25,000/- before this Court within a period of two weeks from today. According to him, this amount has been deposited in view of the fact that the Human Rights Commission, while granting compensation on account of the death of the husband of the present Applicant, determined the amount of compensation and granted Rs. 1,25,000/- as the share of the mother of the deceased. It is his submission that in view of bona fide shown by Applicant, her liberty be protected.

2. Learned APP opposed granting any ad-interim relief.

3. Applicant is a lady. The voluntary statement made by Counsel for Applicant on instructions is accepted as undertaking. Considering bona

fide shown by Applicant, her liberty is protected. However, in case amount of Rs.1,25,000/- is not deposited within a period of two weeks from today, this order shall stand vacated without further reference to this Court.

Hence, the order:

ORDER

- (i) Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 03.07.2026. Learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent Nos. 1 & 2.
- (ii) Till next date, in the event of arrest the Applicant in connection with C.R. No. 25/2025 registered with Parali City Police Station, Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under Sections 107, 120-B, 197, 198, 177, 415, 420, 403, 405, 406, 409 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, she shall be released on bail on furnishing PR bond of Rs. 15,000 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) with one surety in the like amount.
- (iii) She shall attend the concerned police station as and when required.
- (iv) She shall not contact the witnesses directly or indirectly.
- (v) She shall not interfere with the evidence in any manner whatsoever.
- (vi) She is further directed to cooperate the investigating agency for further investigation.

4. Learned APP to communicate this order to concerned police station.
