PER COURT :-

1. Applicant seeks anticipatory bail in connection with Crime No. 0098 of 2025 registered with Degloor Police Station, Dist. Nanded for the offences punishable under Sections 137(2), 64(2)(i)(m), 69, 87 read with Section 4, 8 and 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act.

2. Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is the maternal uncle of the co-accused and the allegation against him is that he provided accommodation to the co-accused and victim girl. It is his submission that co-accused is already enlarged on bail. According to him, charge sheet has filed. As such, custodial interrogation is not necessary.

3. Learned APP opposes grant of any ad-interim protection to

the applicant.

4. *Prima facie*, perusal of the record indicates that this is a possible case of love affair between the victim girl and the co-accused. This Court finds substance in the contention of the learned counsel for the applicant that the offence of abetment may not get attracted against the present applicant. Since applicant is said to have no criminal history behind him hence, his liberty deserves to be protected till the prosecution is heard in the matter. Hence the order :-

ORDER

- (i) Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 09.07.2026. Learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent No. 1.
- (ii) Till next date, in the event of arrest the Applicant – Saibaba Paramesh Namewar in connection with Crime No. 0098 of 2025 registered with Degloor Police Station, Dist. Nanded for the offences punishable under Sections 137(2), 64(2)(i)(m), 69, 87 read with Section 4, 8 and 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, he shall be released on bail on furnishing PR bond of Rs. 15,000 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) with one surety in the like amount.
- (iii) He shall attend the concerned police station once as and when called.
- (iv) He shall not contact the witnesses directly or indirectly.
- (v) He shall not interfere with the evidence in any manner whatsoever.
- (vi) He is further directed to cooperate the

investigating agency for further investigation.

5. Learned APP to communicate this order to concerned police station.
