PER COURT :-

1. Applicants apprehend arrest in connection with Crime No. 0326 of 2026 registered with Bidkin Police Station, Dist. Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar for the offences punishable under Sections 109, 326(F), 74, 189(2), 191(2), 115(2), 351(2), 324(4) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that as far as present applicants are concerned, the offences alleged against them are bailable in nature. It is his submission that offences punishable under Section 109 of the B. N. S. does not get attracted against them. He submits that applicants have no criminal history behind them.

3. Learned APP opposes grant of any ad-interim protection to the applicants.

4. *Prima facie* perusal of the First Information Report supports

the contention of the learned counsel for the applicants. Applicants have no criminal history. Hence, their liberty deserves to be protected till prosecution is heard in the matter. Hence, the order:-

ORDER

(i) Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 29.06.2026. Learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent No. 1.

(ii) Till next date, in the event of arrest the Applicants – 1) Hasina Shaikh Umar Shaikh 2) Sayyed Husena Sayyed Abdul 3) Anvar Babamiya Shaikh 4) Sayyed Saddam Abdul Sayyed 5) Dilavar Babamiya Shaikh in connection with Crime No. 0326 of 2026 registered with Bidkin Police Station, Dist. Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar for the offences punishable under Sections 109, 326(F), 74, 189(2), 191(2), 115(2), 351(2), 324(4) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, they shall be released on bail on furnishing PR bond of Rs. 15,000 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) each with one surety in the like amount.

(iii) They shall attend the concerned police station once as and when called.

(iv) They shall not contact the witnesses directly or indirectly.

(v) They shall not interfere with the evidence in any manner whatsoever.

(vi) They is further directed to cooperate the investigating agency for further investigation.

5. Learned APP to communicate this order to concerned police station.
