**PER COURT :-**

1. Learned Advocate for applicants seeks issuance of notice to applicant Nos. 1 and 2.
2. As far as applicant Nos. 3 to 5 are concerned, it is his submission that considering the role attributed against them in the First Information Report and also in view of the fact that the liberty of these applicants is protected by the Sessions Court till date, said order is extended.
3. Learned APP opposes grant of any interim relief to these applicants.
4. *Prima facie*, perusal of the record indicates that by order dated 02.06.2026, passed in Criminal Bail M.A. No. 311/2026, interim

protection granted to applicant Nos. 3 to 5 came to be extended for a period of two weeks.

5. In view of the facts of the case, this Court finds no reason not to extend interim protection. Hence, issue notice to respondents, returnable on 30.06.2026. Learned APP waives service of notice for respondent-State. Till the next date interim protection granted by Sessions Court to continue.
