P.C.:-

The present Writ Petition takes exception to order dated 08.06.2026 passed by Divisional Registrar and Divisional Joint Registrar (Money-Lending), whereby interim relief granted in pending Appeal Nos.32, 33, 34 and 35 of 2025 directing parties to maintain *status quo* came to be vacated and hearing of Appeals is posted on 30.06.2026.

2. The learned Advocate appearing for petitioners submits that respondent no.1 had granted interim relief in favour of petitioner, thereby directing parties to maintain *status quo* and Appeals were posted for hearing on 17.02.2026. However, since petitioners failed to proceed with Appeals, interim relief is now vacated.

3. Looking to impugned order, it can be observed that Appeals are posted for hearing on 30.06.2026. The learned Advocate



appearing for petitioners, on instructions, undertakes to work out

Appeals on given date without seeking further adjournment.

4. In light of aforesaid undertaking, innocuous order can be passed, thereby protecting interest of petitioners till next date of hearing i.e. 30.06.2026. Hence, Writ Petition stands **disposed of** by continuing interim relief granted in favour of petitioners till 30.06.2026.

5. Needless to state here that, this Court has not gone into merits of contentions of parties and continuation of interim relief is only to secure early hearing of Appeals and to protect *status quo* as regards to suit property till Appeals are being heard.
