PER COURT :-

1. Applicant apprehends arrest in connection with Crime No. 0019 of 2026 registered with Jinsi Police Station, Dist. Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar for the offences punishable under Sections 92, 115(2), 352, read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for applicant submits that as per the case of informant herself, she was carrying two month pregnancy and hence, it is practically impossible that the applicant would know about it so that intentionally she hits the stomach of the informant. It is his contention that even if allegations in the First Information Report are accepted to be true, no evidence is made out against her. Applicant has no criminal history behind him. He therefore, seeks liberty of the applicant be protected.
3. Learned APP opposes grant of any interim protection to the applicant.

4. *Prima facie*, perusal of the First Information Report supports the contention of the learned counsel for the applicant that no knowledge of pregnancy of the informant may be attributed to the applicant. Hence, her liberty deserves to be protected. Hence, the order:-

ORDER

(i) Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 01.07.2026. Learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of respondent-State.

(ii) Till next date, in the event of arrest the Applicant - Shaheda Begum Anis Khan in connection with Crime No. 0019 of 2026 registered with Jinsi Police Station, Dist. Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar for the offences punishable under Sections 92, 115(2), 352, read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, she shall be released on bail on furnishing PR bond of Rs. 15,000 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) with one surety in the like amount.

(iii) She shall attend the concerned police station as and when called with written intimation.

(iv) She shall not contact the witnesses directly or indirectly.

(v) She shall not interfere with the evidence in any manner whatsoever.

(vi) She is further directed to cooperate the investigating agency for further investigation.

5. Learned APP to communicate this order to concerned police station.
