PER COURT :-

1. Not on board. Upon mentioning taken on board.
2. Heard Mr. Dhake, learned Advocate appearing for petitioner.
3. In proceeding under Section 125 of Criminal Procedure Code vide petition E No.132 of 2021, order granting maintenance is passed against Mahendra Suresh Patil, who is respondent No.3. Petitioner is father of Mahendra.
4. Since he failed to deposit maintenance amount, learned Judge, Family Court, Jalgaon directed petitioner to furnish all details of income and expenditure of properties standing in his name including nature of standing crop and current stage on or before 02.07.2025. In default, direction is given to attach standing crop by following procedure of law.
5. Learned Advocate appearing for petitioner submits that one agricultural land is ancestral property another is self-acquired property

of petitioner. However, ignoring those aspects, aforesaid directions are given.

6. Mr. Dhake, learned Advocate for petitioner, on instructions, undertakes that petitioner is ready to deposit amount of Rs.50,000/-(Rupees Fifty thousand only) with Family Court Jalgaon within a period of two weeks from today.

7. In view of aforesaid undertaking and subject to deposit of aforesaid amount, he seeks stay to impugned order.

8. In that view of the matter, issue notice to respondent Nos. 1 and 2, returnable on 23.07.2025.

9. In addition to Court service notice, petitioner shall be at liberty to serve respondent Nos.1 and 2 by any other alternate mode as permissible under law and file affidavit of service by returnable date.

10. Till then, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause 'D' subject to condition that petitioner deposits amount of Rs.50,000/-(Rupees Fifty thousand) with Family Court Jalgaon within a period of two (02) weeks from today.
