1. None present. The above numbered batch of First Appeals/Civil Application came to be listed for the third time on the board of Registrar (Judicial). All the matters came to be filed in the year 2023. However, no steps appear to have been taken.

2. It is necessary to state here that these matters were listed on the board of Registrar (Judicial) for the first time wherein

two weeks time was granted for the purpose of removing office objections. Subsequently, having not taken any steps, the matters were again listed, wherein one week was granted and even at this stages, no steps were taken to remove the objections. In totality, three weeks time was granted till today. However, the appellants/applicant appear to be not keen to remove the office objections and proceed with these matters. In these circumstances, fitness of thing requires refusal of registration instead of keeping these matters pending without any steps been taken. However, instead of passing any stringent order outrightly, I am of the considered view that in the interest of natural justice, one more opportunity needs to be granted, which opportunity cannot be without any condition and hence I pass following order.

ORDER

Two more weeks time is granted to remove the office objections. It is also made clear that on failure on the part of appellants/applicant to remove the office objections within stipulated period of two weeks as stated herein, further coercive order shall be passed.
