PER COURT :-

1. This is an application seeking stay to the execution and operation of the impugned judgment and award.
2. Perused the application and impugned judgment. Heard learned Advocate for the applicants. Considering the fact that the applicant/owner of offending vehicle was not present before the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Nandurbar, it would be proper to grant conditional stay to the execution and operation of the impugned judgment and award.
3. Issue notice to the respondent no.1, returnable on 04.03.2026.
4. Meanwhile, there shall be ad-interim-stay to the execution and operation of the impugned judgment and award on condition that appellants shall deposit the 50% amount under impugned judgment and award with the Registry of this Court.
5. Appellants are directed deposit the 1/2 of the amount i.e. 1/4 of the entire amount within a month and remaining 1/2 amount

i.e. 1/4, within four months from today.

6. If the award amount is not deposited as directed above, ad-interim-stay granted by this Court shall be vacated without further reference to this Court.
