Mr. V.D. Salunke, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that, there are 32 Petitions filed by him, however, only in 15 Writ Petitions, the affidavit in reply is served by the office of the Government Pleader. The petitioners wish to file the rejoinder affidavit. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits

that, the rejoinder affidavit in those 15 Petitions will be filed by 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2016.

2. We make it clear that, in case, the affidavit in reply is not filed by the Respondent/State on or before 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 in each of the Petitions, the Principal Secretary of the concerned Department shall deposit cost of Rs.25,000/-. In case no reply is filed by the District Social Welfare Officer in each of the matters, which are listed for hearing today, on or before 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2016, he shall deposit cost of Rs. 10,000/-.

3. Thereafter, further two weeks time is granted to the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners for filing the Rejoinder Affidavit.

4. List on 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2016.

5. Meantime, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners undertakes to deposit the deficit court fees within four weeks from today.
