1. None present. The present First Appeals are listed for the third time for removal of objections. These matters came to be filed in the year 2024. In these matters one week time was granted for removing office objection. However, on failure to remove the same, further time of one week was extended.

Instead of passing coercive order, one more opportunity on principle of natural justice is allowed by imposing condition. Hence, following order.
