1. Heard learned advocate for the petitioner.

2. This petition is filed by the employee who had filed a reference before the Labour Court, Ahmednagar. The said reference came to be dismissed under Section 59 of the Maharashtra Recognition of Trade Unions and Prevention of Unfair Labour Practices Act (for short "MRTU & PULP Act). The learned advocate for the petitioner submits that, in fact, the bar under Section 59 operates only when decision is rendered under the MRTU & PULP Act. In the present case, complaint was dismissed for default when even the evidence has not started. He relies upon the judgment in the case of C. S. Dixit Vs. Bajaj Tempo Ltd.¹
