. The present Writ Petitions are listed for the third time for removal of objections. These matters are filed in the year 2025 and 2026. Initially, one week time was granted for removing office objections. However, on failure to remove the same, further time of one week was extended.

Instead of passing coercive order, one more opportunity on principle of natural justice is allowed by imposing condition. Hence, following order.
