PER COURT :-

1. The learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the outstanding amount is Rs.43 lakhs. He states that the earlier amounts deposited by the petitioner are not reflected in the account.
2. The learned Counsel for the petitioners has drawn attention to page No.178 of the petition, wherein it is stated that, as on 07/10/2025, the petitioner was shown to be liable for Rs.87,18,550.13, out of which he had already deposited Rs.43.50 lakhs. He submits that, as of today, the outstanding amount is Rs.45 lakhs. He also submits that, at the time of attachment of the property, the petitioner had deposited an additional amount of Rs.2 lakhs, which is also not reflected either in the account or in the bank statement.
3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner reiterates that the petitioner will deposit Rs.30 lakhs in this Court within one week.
4. Considering these submissions, if the petitioner deposits an amount of Rs.30 lakhs in this Court within one week, the further auction scheduled on

06/12/2025 shall remain stayed. However, the petitioner shall deposit the said amount on or before 04/12/2025.

5. List the matter on 04/12/2025 in the same category, immediately after fresh admission matters.

6. In the event the petitioner fails to deposit the amount as directed, the interim order passed today shall cease to remain in force.
