2. Petitioner worked as Shikshan Sevak/Junior College Lecturer with respondent No.6 for the period from 01.07.2005 to 26.06.2011. He, thereafter, resigned from service for the purpose of joining as Shikshan Sevak/Junior College Lecturer with respondent No.4. Respondent No.4 has appointed petitioner as Shikshan Sevak.

3. Argument is that, in terms of Government Resolution dated 15.09.2011, the petitioner is entitled for appointment as Junior College Lecturer by extending benefits of services, which he rendered earlier. Further argument is that despite order passed by respondent No.1 directing respondent No.4 to submit the proposal in terms of said Government Resolution, he has failed to do so.

4. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable in three weeks.

5. In addition to the usual mode of service, the petitioner shall serve the respondents by all permissible modes including service by sped post a/d and shall file affidavit of service.

6. A.G.P waives service of notice for respondent No.2.

Meanwhile, we direct respondent No.2 to take necessary steps by issuing appropriate directions to the other respondents, if the petitioner is otherwise entitled for the benefits in terms of the Government Resolution dated 15.09.2011. We also call upon respondent No.6 to explain as to why was proposal not sent, as directed by respondent No.1.
