1. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Appellant and learned counsel appearing for the non-applicant/respondent nos.1, 2 and 3. None for the Non-applicant/respondent no.4.

2. By the present application, the non-applicant /Original Claimants in MACP No.82/2020 prayed for permission for withdrawal of 50% of the amount deposited by the Appellant/Insurance Company in pursuance of the order dated 5.12.2025 passed in First Appeal.

3. On face of record, it appears that as per order dated 28.7.2025, this Court granted the non-applicants/original Claimants to withdraw 50% of the compensation amount and the remaining 50% of compensation amount directed to invest in the F.D.R. However, the compensation amount was not deposited



prior to 12th December, 2025. Hence, this Court again passed an order and permitted the appellant/Insurance Company to deposit 50% of the entire amount. Since, the Appellant/Insurance Company deposited entire amount of compensation, therefore, it would be just and proper to permit the non-applicant nos.1, 2 and 3 - Original Claimants to withdraw 50% along with accrued interest of the compensation amount on furnishing their usual Undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registry of this Court.

4. Accordingly, civil application stands disposed of.
