5. Learned Additional Government Pleader waives service of notice on behalf of respondent Nos.15 and 16/State.

Petitioner (s) is/are permitted to serve the remaining respondent(s) by private mode of service, in addition to regular mode of service and shall file an affidavit of service by next date, failing which the petitioner (s) shall deposit costs of Rupees Five Hundred with the Public Welfare Account maintained with Union Bank of India, High Court Branch, Civil Lines, Nagpur, bearing Account No. 129712010001014 and IFSC Code No. UBIN0812978.

7. Office objections, if any, shall be removed on or before next date.

8. Meanwhile, respondent Nos. 1 to 9 are directed not to take any major policy decision.
