Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

2. The petitioner has challenged the judgment and order dated 14.02.2026 passed by the appellate Court reversing the order of temporary injunction which was granted in favour of the petitioners/plaintiffs.

3. In view of the controversy involved, issue notice for final disposal to the respondents, returnable on 26.03.2026.

4. Mr. Dhawas, learned counsel waives service of notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

5. The petitioners are permitted to serve the remaining respondents by private mode, in addition to regular mode of service and file affidavit of service in that regard by next date.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the interim relief restraining the respondents from creating third-party interest during the pendency of the proceedings was operating even during the pendency of the appeal and therefore, he prays for grant of interim relief.

7. In view of this, it is directed that the respondents are restrained from creating third-party interest in the suit property, till next date.
