This is an application for condonation of delay in filing the application for restoration of the writ petition of which registration was refused for failure to remove the office objections.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the delay occurred since the applicants were not aware about the conditional order passed by the Registrar (Judicial), in view of which the registration was refused. However, the applicants desire to contest the petition on merits and therefore, seeks condonation of delay, so that the petition is restored.

3. Having regard to the contents of the application and submissions advanced, the delay of 179 days in filing the application for restoration is condoned,

subject to costs of Rs.3,500/- to be deposited with 'Public Welfare Account' bearing No.129712010001014, IFSC Code UBIN0812978, Union Bank of India, Branch High Court, Civil Lines, Nagpur, within a period of two weeks.

Mis. Civil Application (ST) No.5394/2026

By this application, the applicants seek restoration of the writ petition of which registration was refused for failure to remove the office objections by order dated 11.08.2025, passed by the Registrar (Judicial). The applicants submit that they desire to contest the petition on merits, and therefore, seeks restoration of the writ petition.

2. Having regard to the contents of the application and submissions advanced, the application is allowed. The order dated 11.08.2025 passed by the Registrar (Judicial) is quashed and set aside.

3. The applicant is directed to remove the office objections within a period of two weeks. After the objections are removed, the writ petition be restored to its original file.

4. The miscellaneous civil application is allowed and disposed of accordingly.
