1. By this application, the applicant has challenged the order dated 09.02.2026 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Court No.1, Nagpur in SCC No.10221/2025 directing to pay the arrears of the salary and attachment warrant is issued against the present applicant.

2. Heard learned counsel for the applicant. He he invited my attention towards the entire order passed and submitted that the Magistrate has not considered the crucial aspect of the matter and wrongly passed the order. He shown his willingness to deposit the amount to the extent of 25%.

3. In view of that, the attachment warrant issued by the learned 14th Joint Civil Judge Junior Division and Judicial Magistrate First Class, (Court No.1), Nagpur, is stayed on depositing 25%

amount of the total arrears of Rs.31,42,128/- till appearance of the non-applicants. The applicant to deposit the said amount within four weeks in this Court.

5. Issue notice to the non-applicant No.2.
6. Stand over to 11.06.2026.
