2. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 22.04.2026.
3. Learned Additional Government Pleader waives service of notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2/State.
4. Petitioner (s) is/are permitted to serve the remaining respondent (s) by private mode of service, in addition to regular mode of service and shall file an affidavit of service by next date, failing which the petitioner (s) shall deposit costs of Rs.500/- (Rs. Five hundred) in the 'Public Welfare Account' bearing No. 129712010001014, IFSC Code No. UBIN0812978 with Union Bank of India, High Court Branch, Civil Lines, Nagpur.
5. Office objections, if any, shall be removed on or before next date.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that renewal of the registration has been rejected solely on the ground that the application for renewal was not submitted prior to 60 days of the expiry of such certificate. Such condition is not a mandatory condition. However, the respondents, on the basis of such rejection, are likely to initiate criminal action against the petitioners.

7. In view of the above, the respondents are directed not to take any coercive action against the petitioners on the basis of such rejection of renewal of the registration.
