1. The applicant is apprehending his arrest in connection with Crime No.40/2026 registered with Police Station, Dhad, District Buldhana for the offences punishable under Sections 118(1), 296, 115, 352, 351(2), 3(5), 308(4), 111(1), 2(b), (3), (4) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. Issue notice to the non-applicant, returnable on **06.04.2026.**

3. Shri Bissa, learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of the non-applicant and prays for time to file reply.

4. It is contended that no role of assault has been attributed to the applicant. It is also contended that the applicant has only allegedly threatened the complainant. It is contended that there is marriage ceremony of the applicant on 25.03.2026.

5. Considering the submissions, detailed scrutiny of the case diary is necessary, which is not available at present. Reply of the State is also yet to be filed on record. In the meanwhile, the applicant can be granted ad interim protection. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

(i) Pending the application, in the event of arrest in connection with Crime No.40/2026 registered with Police Station, Dhad, District Buldhana for the offences punishable under Sections 118(1), 296, 115, 352, 351(2), 3(5), 308(4), 111(1), 2(b), (3), (4) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, the applicant – **Mayur Sunil Apar** be released on bail on furnishing a PR bond of ₹25,000/- with one solvent surety in the like amount.

(ii) The applicant shall attend the concerned Police Station on every Friday and Tuesday between 10.00 am to 12.00 noon for three weeks and cooperate with the investigating authority.

(iii) The applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall not threaten the prosecution witnesses.
