1. Leave to delete Respondent Nos.2 and 3 is granted. Deletion be carried out forthwith.
2. Heard.
3. This Court vide order dated 07.10.2023 passed in Writ Petition No.187 of 2023 filed by the present petitioners, who were some of the petitioners therein, had issued following directions :-

“According to the learned Counsel for the Zilla Parishad it would have to be verified as to whether the petitioners satisfy the criteria of service in naxal/tribal areas including Additional Tribal Sub Plan Area in the district of Chandrapur. Learned counsel does not dispute the fact that this Court in somewhat similar circumstances has extended the special promotional pay-scale under the Government Resolution dated 06/08/2002 to the petitioners in those cases. Accordingly, by following the orders passed in earlier Writ Petitions as mentioned above, the respondent No.3-Zilla Parishad is directed to verify the services of all the petitioners of having being discharged in naxal/tribal areas including the Additional Tribal Sub Plan Area in the district of Chandrapur. On such verification, the special promotional pay-scale under the Government Resolution dated 06/08/2002 be released in their

favour. In case the petitioners are found entitled for arrears of one step special promotional pay-scale in terms of Government Resolution dated 06/08/2002, the Zilla Parishad shall make the payment of arrears in accordance with the recommendations of 6th and 7th Pay Commissions. The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of four months from today.”

4. As could be seen, Respondent No.3 therein, who was represented by Respondent No.1 herein, was directed to verify the services of all the petitioners and to extend benefit of the pay scale as permissible under the Government Resolution dated 06.08.2002. The Court directed the present respondent to complete the entire exercise within four months from the date of the order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that nothing has been done till date despite making several representations.

6. On the strength of the submissions so made, which will be tested in due course, issue notice to the respondents under Form 1 of Chapter 34 of the Bombay High Court Appellate Side Rules, 1960, against Respondent Shri Pulkit Singh, Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Chandrapur,, made returnable on **07.07.2026**.
