By this application applicant is seeking condonation of delay which is caused in preferring revision challenging the order of Family Court in Petition No.145/2022.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that due to financial constrain and parents of the present applicants were suffering from various ailments. She could not approach to the counsel and could not file revision in time therefore, delay of 4 days is caused.

3. Considering the reasons mentioned in the application which appears to be justifiable and reasonable. More over it is well settled that while considering the delay

application liberal approach is to be taken and not pedantic approach as the valuable rights of the parties are involved.

4. In view of that and considering the reasons mentioned in the application which appears to be just and reasonable, the application deserves to be allowed.

5. Accordingly I proceed to pass the following order:-

(i) Application is allowed.

(ii) Delay of 4 days is condoned.

(iii) Revision be numbered.

6. Applicant is permitted to serve non-applicant and shall file affidavit of service on record.
