1. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 15th June, 2026.
2. Mrs. M.S. Naik, learned A.G.P. waives service of notice on behalf of respondent No.1.
3. Mr. Viren Joshi h/f. Mr. N.A. Gaikwad, learned counsel waives service of notice on behalf of respondent No.3.
4. Notice to be served to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 by all modes permissible in law including regular mode of service and the counsel for the petitioner to file affidavit of service in that regard before the returnable date.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner points us out order of this Court in Writ Petition No.5039/2025 passed on 3rd September, 2025. By way of said order, it was directed that the respondent No.3 – State Common Entrance Test Cell, Mumbai not to cancel the admission of the petitioner from Scheduled Tribe category till the result of the Caste Scrutiny Committee.

6. He, therefore, prays for extension of such direction as the admission of the petitioner stands protected by the earlier order referred supra.

7. In that view of the matter, the respondent No.3 is directed not to cancel the admission of the petitioner from the Scheduled Tribe category till further orders.
