1. Heard Shri. C. R. Kulkarni, learned counsel for petitioner.
2. The contention is that the petitioner was awarded a contract for the services to be provided under the title “Manpower Outsourcing Services” by the respondent – Yantra India Limited, Ordinance Factory, Ambazari. Such contract dated 26.08.2025 is at record page No.32 (Annexure-B).
3. A perusal of the aforesaid contract reveals that the tenure of the aforesaid contract is for twelve months commencing from 28.08.2025 and ending on 27.08.2026.
4. Shri. Kulkarni, learned counsel for petitioner, submits that without terminating such contract awarded in favour of the petitioner, the respondent has issued a fresh tender on 28.03.2026 for the same work. The bid document is at record page No.56 (Annexure – H).
5. In view of the above, issue notice to the respondent, returnable on 17.04.2026.
6. The petitioner is permitted to serve the respondent by private mode in addition to regular mode of service and file an

affidavit of service by next date, failing which the petitioner shall deposit costs of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) with “Public Welfare Account” bearing No.129712010001014, IFSC Code UBIN0812978 with Union Bank of India, Branch High Court, Civil Lines, Nagpur.

7. Office objection(s), if any, shall be removed before next date.

8. In the meanwhile, if the bids are open in pursuance to the tender notice dated 28.03.2026, the further procedure conducted by the respondent shall be subject to the result of the present writ petition.
