1. Heard learned Advocate for the petitioner.
2. The petitioner's challenge is to the order dated 03.10.2024, passed by Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner, Nagpur, under Sections 14-B and 7-Q of the Employees Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.
3. Learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that in an identical matter bearing ***Writ Petition No.5318 of 2024, M/s. Becquerel Industries Private Limited, Nagpur through Authorized Signatory, Mr. Padmakar Pisal Vs. Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner-I, Regional Office, Nagpur***, raising the same issue, this Court has issued notices and granted interim relief subject to deposit of 25% of the amount as per the impugned order.

4. Having regard to the controversy involved, issue notice to the respondent, returnable on 15th June 2026.

5. The petitioner is permitted to serve the respondent by private mode, in addition to regular mode of service and file affidavit of service in that regard by next date.

6. In the meantime, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause (iii), subject to deposit of 25% of the amount mentioned in the impugned order with the Registry of this Court, within a period of one week from today.
