Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

2. The petitioners' challenge is to order dated 06.04.2026 passed by the Maharashtra Revenue Tribunal, Nagpur, thereby rejecting the application for stay filed by the petitioners in the revision application.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that only the operative portion of the order is supplied to the petitioners, however, the reasons for rejecting the application are not yet supplied. He also points out that, by the same order, the petitioners are protected only for a period of ten days from that date. He submits that the petitioners are in cultivating possession of land in question

since 1951 and based on the impugned order rejecting the application for stay, the petitioners' possession is likely to be disturbed.

4. In view of this, issue notice to the respondents, returnable after four weeks.

5. Learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 2/State.

6. The petitioners are permitted to serve the remaining respondents by private mode, in addition to regular mode of service and file affidavit of service in that regard by next date.

7. In the meantime, the petitioners' possession shall not be disturbed.
