Petitioner alleges contempt against the respondents saying that they have willfully disobeyed the order dated 08.05.2025 passed by this Court in Writ Petition No.2466/2022. By the said order, the respondents were directed to decide representation of the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible with outer limit of three weeks from the date of production of copy of the order.

2. In context with the aforesaid direction, we inquired with the petitioners' counsel as to before whom the representation was made, to which he submits that representation was made before respondent No.4.

3. If that be so, the petitioner shall justify alleging contempt against other respondents. So far as respondent No.4 is concerned, we call upon him to show cause as to why contempt proceedings should not be initiated against him.

4. Accordingly, we issue notice to respondent No.4, returnable in two weeks.
