This Court, on 17.06.2026, issued notice to the respondents and also granted interim relief in terms of prayer clause Nos. (iii), (iv) and (v). However, inadvertently, the appointment of the Court Commissioner could not be made.

2. Today, therefore, Mr. De circulated the matter at 2:30 p.m. for appointment of a 'Court Commissioner' to carry out the search of various premises and establishments of the respondents, including shops, and to seize the infringing labels, incriminating material, etc.

3. Accordingly Mr. Amol Gase, Advocate is hereby appointed as Court Commissioner in the matter.

4. The learned Court Commissioner is directed to visit the premises of the respondents' shops and seize/take custody of all impugned goods bearing the infringing trademarks. The Court Commissioner shall thereafter submit a detailed report before this Hon'ble Court.

5. The appellants to deposit Rs.25,000/- (Rs.Twenty Five thousand only) in this Court towards fees of Court Commissioner.

6. Stand over to 02.07.2026.
