1. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 18th June, 2026.
2. Notice to be served to the respondents by all modes permissible in law including regular mode of service.
3. The challenge in the present petition is to the judgment and order dated 4th May, 2026 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Akola, in Criminal Appeal No.125/2026.
4. By way of said judgment the Sessions Judge has set aside the order dated 2nd March, 2026 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Akola, below Exh.-5 and has ordered the petitioner herein to vacate the house in question.
5. It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners that after passing of the said order 15 days time was granted by the Appellate to approach this Court.
6. It is his further contention that in spite of an application moved for extension of the said interim protection, the same was not entertained. He has filed affidavit of the

petitioner and the certified copy of the order of extension to support his contention. The petitioner submits that they are still in possession of the house in question.

7. In that view of the matter, the parties to maintain *status-quo* as far as possession is concerned till next date.
