1. Heard.
2. The petitioner has pointed out that as per the provisions of the Maharashtra Restoration of Lands to Scheduled Tribes Act, 1974, the cut off date to cover the cases under the Act is 6.7.1974. However, in the present case, the transaction is of year 17.1.1994. Hence, the provisions of this Act is not applicable. Consequently, the proceedings which were filed before the Tahsildar are also not tenable.
3. According to the petitioner, the respondent no.2 was having a remedy to file a proceeding under Section 36 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code before the Collector.
4. This matter pertaining to the transaction between the two agriculturists. Therefore, the hearing opportunity to the respondent no.2 is also necessary. However, Advocate Mane, who has filed power on behalf of respondent no.2, is absent when the matter is taken up for final hearing.
5. In the circumstances, to grant one more opportunity to the respondent no.2, list this matter on 22.6.2026.
