1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant (s).
2. Apprehending arrest in connection with Crime No.0250 of 2026 registered with Police Station Pinjar, District Akola, on 30.04.2026, for the offences punishable under Sections 75, 79, 333, 351(2) and 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, the applicant has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail.
3. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the dispute is basically pertaining to the payment which was to be made by the complainant for the establishment of a mandap by the present applicant for a Haldi function organised at the place of the complainant. He has invited my attention to the counter FIR bearing

No.0251 of 2026 registered on 30.04.2026, i.e. on the same day, by the present applicant with Police Station Pinjar, District Akola, against the complainant herein and other relatives for the offences alleged under Sections 296, 351(2) and 352 of the BNS, 2023.

4. Mr. Sagdeo, the learned counsel for the applicant, submits that the learned Sessions Court has rejected the anticipatory bail application of the present applicant though the learned APP appearing on behalf of the State could not point out a single reason for the custody of the present applicant in the present offence. The learned Sessions Court has rejected the aforesaid application by giving a reason in Para 8 that it appears that the applicant has no respect for women and he does not bother about their age or social status.

5. Therefore, in my considered opinion, the anticipatory bail of the present applicant could not have been rejected solely on such a ground and accordingly, the following order is passed :-

ORDER

(i) Issue notice to the non-applicants, returnable on **12.06.2026**.

(ii) The learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of the non-applicant-State.

(iii) In the event of arrest in connection with Crime No. 0250 of 2026 registered with Police Station Pinjar, District Akola, on 30.04.2026, for the offences punishable under Sections 75, 79, 333,

351(2), and 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, the applicant shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail upon furnishing a PR Bond of Rs. 30,000/- with one solvent surety in the like amount.

(iv) The applicant shall attend the concerned Police Station on every Monday between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. till the filing of the charge-sheet and shall cooperate with the Investigating Officer.

(v) The applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of this Court.
