1. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to correct the date in prayer clause (a) and (b).
2. Leave granted. Necessary amendment be carried out forthwith.
3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. Petitioner's challenge is to the order dated 11.05.2026 passed by the respondent, by which the petitioner is transferred from Primary Health Center Talegaon Dashasar, Tahsil Dhamangaon Railway to Primary Health Center at Sadarawadi, Tahsil Dharni, District Amravati (i.e. tribal area).
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner points out that the petitioner was appointed by an order dated 14.10.2024 issued by the respondent and even before completion of the probation period of two years, she is transferred to a tribal area, contrary to the Government Resolution dated 15.05.2014. It is also submitted that the petitioner's husband is working at Zilla Parishad, Amravati and that the petitioner is having a child of two years. Learned counsel

for the petitioner further states that the place of transfer is situated at a distance of more than 150 kilometres from the petitioner's existing place and therefore, the petitioner prays for interim relief. It is also submitted that the petitioner has not yet handed over charge of the post of "Health Assistant (Women) and therefore, prays for interim relief.

6. In view of this, issue notice to respondent, returnable on **19.06.2026**.

7. Petitioner is permitted to serve the respondent by private mode, in addition to regular mode of service and file affidavit of service in that regard by next date.

8. In the meantime, the impugned order dated 11.05.2026 passed by the respondent shall remain stayed, till next date.
