1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. Petitioners' appeal under Section 18(4) of the Maharashtra Money Lending Act, 2014 (for short "the Act") came to be dismissed by an order dated 05.05.2026 passed by respondent No.7 - The Divisional Joint Registrar, Money Lending and Divisional Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Amravati. Thereafter, petitioners attempted to file a revision application under Section 9 of the Act, before respondent No.8 – The Registrar General/ Commissioner, Cooperative Societies, Pune, on 29.05.2026. However, it is submitted that the revision application is not yet registered. Petitioners apprehend disturbance to their possession in view of the order passed by the Appellate Authority.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners points out that during the pendency of the appeal, the petitioners' possession was protected by virtue of an order dated 13.11.2025 passed by respondent No.7 - The Divisional

Joint Registrar, Money Lending and Divisional Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Amravati. It is also submitted that petitioners are having the possession of the agricultural land since the year 2014, which is maintained till today and in view of the fact that the revision application is not registered, the petitioners apprehend the disturbance to their possession.

4. In view of the controversy raised, issue notice to respondents, returnable on **19.06.2026**.

5. Learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of respondent Nos.5 to 8/State.

6. Petitioners are permitted to serve remaining respondents by private mode, in addition to regular mode of service and file affidavit of service in that regard by next date.

7. In the meantime, possession of petitioners over the agricultural land shall not be disturbed, till next date.
