2. Issue notice to the non-applicant, returnable on 06.07.2026.
3. Learned APP waives notice for non-applicant/State.
4. The applicant is seeking ad-interim bail in Crime No.474/2026 registered with Police Station Rajura, District Chandrapur dated 16.05.2026 for the offence punishable under Section 108 and 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023.
5. In the present matter, the allegation against the present applicant is only that he helped one Sarita Ramkishor Singh, who is the girlfriend of the deceased, in lodging the complaint. There are no specific allegations against the present applicant that he committed any act

which was the reason for the deceased to commit suicide. As such, considering the role attributed to the present applicant, as alleged in the First Information Report, in my opinion, the custody of the present applicant is not required in the matter. In the circumstances, the applicant is entitled for interim protection in the matter till next date. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following order:

**ORDER**

- i) In the event of arrest in Crime No.No.474/2026 registered with Police Station Rajura, District Chandrapur dated 16.05.2026 for the offence punishable under Section 108 and 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023, the Applicant – Rajendra Vitthal Dohe be released on bail on his executing PR Bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one solvent surety in the like amount.
- ii) The Applicant shall attend the Police Station, Rajura, District Chandrapur, on Monday and Friday of every week till the next date of the matter.
- iii) The Applicant shall also attend the Police Station, Rajura, District Chandrapur, if otherwise required on other days by the investigation officer with prior intimation from the investigation officer.
- iv) The Applicant shall, at the time of execution of bond, furnish his address and telephone/mobile number(s) to the Investigating Officer and the Court

concerned, and shall not change the same till the final disposal of the case.

v) The Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any witness acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or any Police Officer.

vi) The Applicant shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the Investigating officer.

6. Stand over to 06.07.2026.
