. Heard Shri. M. F. Danish, learned counsel for the petitioners.

2. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking a direction to the learned Ad-hoc District Judge-I, Akola to dispose of Election Petition No.3 of 2025 expeditiously by granting hearing on day-to-day basis.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the aforesaid petition pertains to the election of a disqualified candidate and the pendency of the aforesaid petition will entail the disqualified councillor to continue during his tenure.

4. A perusal of the petition reveals that the petitioners have already approached the learned District Judge-I, Akola, by filing an application below Exhibit - 20, which is at record page No.52 (Annexure - 4) raising their grievance and pointing out the grounds for grant of early disposal of the aforesaid election petition.

5. The said application seems to have been filed by the petitioners on 07.01.2026. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that even after passage of almost six months now, even the



aforesaid application is not yet decided by the learned Trial Court and accordingly, the petitioners have approached this Court.

6. In view of the above, we dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the learned Ad-hoc District Judge-I, Akola, to decide the aforesaid application, below Exhibit - 20, which is at record page No.52 (Annexure - 4), filed by the petitioners, by considering the grounds raised in the aforesaid application, in accordance with law and on its own merits, within a stipulated period of two weeks from the next date of hearing.

7. The present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
