By this petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondent No.1 Scheduled Tribe Caste Certificate Scrutiny Committee, Amravati to decide caste claim of the petitioner within stipulated period. The petitioner also seeking the interim relief as he is already selected for training in respondent No.2 institute. It is submitted that the petitioner belongs to the Thakur Scheduled Tribe which is recognized at Sr.No.44 in the list of the Scheduled Tribe Notification. In view of the advertisement issued by respondent No.2 for the Schedule Tribe candidates to Free Police/Army Training for the year 2024-25, the petitioner applied for the same. He appeared for the written examination and his name is at Serial No.11 in the merit list. Now, he is called for the document verification on or before 12.06.2026. However, as his claim is still pending before the respondent No.1 Committee, he is having apprehension that he would not be permitted to take

part in further process of document verification, and therefore, by way of interim prayer, he is seeking directions to the respondent No.2 to permit him to appear for the document verification process.

2. Learned AGP waives notice for respondent Nos.1 and 2 and seeks time to file reply.

3. By way of interim relief, the respondent No.2 shall permit the petitioner to appear for document verification.

4. Stand over to 25.06.2026.
