2. The petitioner challenges the impugned orders passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, which was confirmed by the Collector as well as Additional Commissioner, whereby the application filed by the respondent No.6 for right to way came to be allowed by the learned Sub-Divisional Officer.
3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on **29.06.2026**.
4. Ms. P.T. Joshi, learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 and prays for time to file reply.
5. In addition to usual mode of service, the petitioner is permitted to serve the other respondents by any private mode available in law.
6. The contention of the petitioner is that the order of learned Sub-Divisional Officer is sought to be executed by the

Tahsildar. It is also contended that during pendency of appeal as well as revision, parties were directed to maintain status-quo.

7. Considering the submission, parties are directed to maintain status-quo till returnable date.
