1. Heard. Issue notice to the Non-applicant, returnable on 16th June, 2026.
2. Ms. Kavimandan, the learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of the Non-applicant/State.
3. The Applicants are apprehending arrest in Crime No. 65/2026 registered with Police Station, Mahila Thana, Raipur Commissionarate (Chhattisgarh) for the offence punishable under Sections 3(5) and 85 of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023.
4. Perusal of the averments made in the complaint lodged by the Informant/Complainant *prima facie* shows that there are no details as to when and how she was harassed at the hands of present Applicants. The allegations are vague and omnibus in nature.
5. In view of this, Applicants have made out a case for

ad interim protection till next date of hearing on the following condition.

In the event of arrest in Crime No. 65/2026 registered with Police Station, Mahila Thana, Raipur Commissionarate (Chhattisgarh State) for the offence punishable under Sections 3(5) and 85 of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023, the Applicants – (i) Shyamsundar Rameshchandra Varma; (ii) Smt. Deepa Shyamsundar Varma; and (iii) Ankit Shyamsundar Varma be released on furnishing PR Bond of Rs.25,000/- with one solvent surety each.
