2. In the present matter, the grievance of the petitioner is that without giving the details to know against what the demand has been raised by the respondent-Electricity Distribution Company to the tune of Rs.3,99,880/-, the electricity supply came to be disconnected.

3. It is submitted that even though the petitioner has deposited Rs.50,000/- and made a representation on 06/05/2026, there is no response to the same or decision on the same. It is submitted that because of disconnection of electricity supply in these summer days, the petitioner's house is without electricity supply.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, makes a statement that the petitioner would deposit 50% of the total demand amount in this Court within a period of two weeks from today with an undertaking that if the petitioner fails in the present petition, he will deposit the balance 50% amount within three weeks.

5. In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the respondent-Electricity Distribution Company is directed to restore the electricity supply of Consumer No.423830008614 and Consumer No.423830008568 forthwith subject to the result of the petition.
