1. Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that though the applicant has challenged the order passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Akola, now he is ready to deposit the costs imposed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge by the impugned order. Learned counsel submits that since the time to deposit the costs is expired, he is unable to deposit the same and the applicant restricts his prayer for extension of time to deposit the costs.
3. Issue notice to the non-applicants, returnable on 10.07.2026.
4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor waives service of notice on behalf of the non-applicant no.2/State.
5. In addition to regular mode, the applicant/s is/are permitted to serve the non-applicant no.1 by all other private modes as permissible in law.

6. The applicant shall file an affidavit of service to non-applicant no.1 on record, failing which the applicant shall pay costs of Rs.500/- to the “Public Welfare Account” maintained with the Union Bank of India, High Court Branch, Nagpur

7. The applicant may apply before the learned Sessions Court for adjournment till the next date. If such an application is filed by the applicant, the Court may consider the said application favourably.
