1. It is claimed that initial appointment of the petitioner was on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 1986 on the post of Clerk with the respondent. The petitioner was appointed against a post reserved for Scheduled Tribe category as the petitioner was claiming to be belonging to 'Halba' Scheduled Tribe.

2. It appears that non-submission of validity has laid to his termination on 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2005. However, vide memorandum dated 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2010 he was granted re-appointment.

3. The initial entry of the petitioner in the service was on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 1986. The petitioner stood superannuated on 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2024 and as such it is claimed that even if for a period from 26.10.2005 to 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2010 even if the petitioner was not in employment, he needs to be granted benefit of continuity for drawing terminal benefits but for the aforesaid period i.e. 2005 to 2010.

4. Issue notice for final disposal to the respondents, returnable on 12.2.2025.
