By way of this Review Application, the review Petitioner seeks recall of the Judgment of this Court dated 15th December 2025, whereby the Petitioner was directed to pay the remaining back wages along with interest at the rate of six percent per annum from the dates of the impugned awards until actual payment is made to the employees or their legal representatives within six weeks of the uploading of the said Order.

2. During the course of hearing, the parties have agreed to settle the matter and accordingly Consent Terms have been drawn and tendered to this Court. The said Consent Terms are taken on record and marked 'X' for identification. The Consent Terms have been signed by all the parties i.e. the Applicant as well as the legal heirs of the deceased Respondent no. 1.
3. All the parties are present in person in the Court today. The Counsel have identified their respective clients/parties.
4. In view of the Consent Terms executed and tendered before the Court, nothing survives for consideration in the present Petition. The Consent Terms shall form part and parcel of the present Order.
5. The Respondent is permitted to withdraw the amounts that have been deposited by the Petitioner in the Registry of this Court. The Registry is directed to permit the Respondent to withdraw the said amounts from the Court.
6. The Review Petition, having worked out, is thus disposed of accordingly

CONSENT TERMS

1. In view of the parties amicably settling the matter, the Legal Heirs of the Respondent No.1 Employee namely Mrs. Mangala Naik (Wife of Deceased), Mrs. Samrudhi Ramesh Naik alias Mrs. Saanvi Santosh Naik (Daughter) and Mrs. Sampada Ramesh Naik alias Mrs. Sampada Gautam Parab shall be entitled to receive an amount of Rs. 6,99,501 which is deposited before this Hon`ble High Court in MCA/227/2012 in WP/326/2010.

2. It is agreed between the parties, that the amount of Rs. 6,99,501 which is deposited in this High Court shall be distributed among the legal heirs in the following ratio:-

- i. Mrs. Mangala Naik (Wife of Deceased Shri Ramesh Naik) – 50%
- ii. Mrs. Samrudhi Ramesh Naik alias Mrs. Saanvi Santosh Naik (Daughter) - 25%
- iii. Mrs. Sampada Ramesh Naik alias Mrs. Sampada Gautam Parab (Daughter) - 25%

3. It is agreed between the parties that the concerned Legal Heirs shall withdraw the said amount deposited in this Hon'ble Court by making appropriate application before ^{The Registry of} this Hon'ble Court.

4. The present consent terms shall be filed in the present Review Application which is presently pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay at Goa.

5. It is agreed between the parties that the Applicant Company shall withdraw the review Application filed before this Hon'ble Court in view of the parties amicably settling the matter.

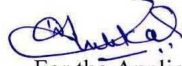
6. On payment of the said amount, the parties shall have no claim of whatsoever nature against each other and all the

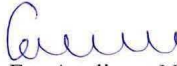
