1. This application is made for extension of time granted to surrender by order dated 07.05.2026. The time expires on 14.05.2026. The earlier orders dated 22.04.2026 and 07.05.2026 were passed on medical grounds though the Applicant is charged with serious offence and also after recording the displeasure of the Court, of non compliance by the Applicant, in its order dated 07.05.2026.

2. I have heard the learned Counsel for the Applicant and the Respondent and have perused the reports annexed to the application. The next follow-up visit with the doctor at Pune is on 18.05.2026.

Therefore, on medical grounds, the time to surrender is extended till 20.05.2026 so that the Applicant can attend to the follow-up appointment on 18.05.2026. The Applicant undertakes to make himself available for Judicial Custody on or before 20.05.2026. Subject to the terms and conditions of order dated 22.04.2026 and 07.05.2026, extension for surrender is granted up to 20.05.2026.
