By way of this Miscellaneous Application, taken out in the accompanying Second Appeal No.6/2025, the Applicant makes a grievance that the Respondents have commenced demolition of old wooden structures which are likely to continue. They therefore, *inter alia*, pray for an order restraining the Respondent Nos.1 to 6, their agents, relations or anybody acting on their behalf from interfering in any manner with the suit plots or erecting any structure in the suit plot or re-erecting structures illegally erected thereon earlier.
2. Mr. Braganza, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the

Respondent Nos. 1 to 6 and 8 appears on private notice, waives service and on instructions, submits that the Respondents will maintain status quo in terms of the prayer clause 'a' of the Application until the next date of hearing. His assurance is accepted as an undertaking to the Court.

3. He also seeks time to file reply. Time as prayed for is granted. Reply to be filed before the next date of hearing with an advance copy to the other side.

4. Since Respondent No.7 is unserved, issue notice to Respondent No.7 made returnable on the next date of hearing. Humdast is permitted.
