1. By way of the present petition, the Petitioner has invoked the supervisory jurisdiction of this Court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, to quash and set aside the order of the learned Administrative Tribunal dated 07.05.2026.

2. A perusal of the order indicates that the order is passed on an application for stay of the order dated 20.01.2026 for which the Petitioner herein had filed Pollution Board Appeal No. 2/2026. The order Inter alia states that after hearing the respective Counsel on the extension of stay, the learned Administrative Tribunal has held that the stay cannot be extended since the consent to operate is rejected on

three prior occasions and no application for consent to operate is presently pending before the Board.

3. The urgency canvassed on behalf of the Advocate for the Petitioner is that the Petition will be rendered infructuous if interim relief is not granted. My attention is invited to a Memorandum issued by the Mamlatdar of Tiswadi Taluka dated 16.05.2026 to execute the order of the Pollution Control Board dated 12.05.2026 directing the Talathi to seal the premises and report compliance. Hence the urgency.

4. Issue notice to the Respondents, made returnable on 28.05.2026.

5. List the matter on 28.05.2026, subject to proof of service upon the Respondents filed by the Petitioner in the Registry.
