The applicant has been convicted for offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. Vide judgment and order dated 19.11.2019 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, First Class "B" Court Vasco and directed to pay compensation Rs.2,50,000/- towards disputed cheque amount. Appeal preferred by the applicant has been dismissed vide judgment and order dated 16.12.2021 passed

by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, South Goa, Margao.

2. Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the revision applicant has deposited an amount of Rs.60,000/- before the Appellate Court during the pendency of the appeal and the applicant is willing to deposit an amount of Rs. 1,90,000/- in this Court vide demand draft no.500381 dated 21.8.2023. It is submitted that conviction warrant has been issued against the applicant. It may be stayed during the pendency of the application.

3. Applicant is permitted to deposit amount of Rs.1,90,000/- before this Court by way of demand draft as stated above within two days from today. Conviction warrant issued against the applicant pursuant to the conviction by the trial Court and dismissal of the appeal by the appellate Court is stayed till next date.
