We have heard the matter in the morning session and the learned AGP is producing the affidavit-in-reply on behalf of respondent no. 2 which is alongwith certain documents including the copy of the order passed by this Court on 11/08/2025. Based upon the said order, it was tried to be submitted on behalf of learned AGP that since the indemnity bonds as directed have not been furnished, the 50% of the compensation has not been released.
2. Learned advocate for the petitioners disputes the same.
3. We had then asked the learned AGP to tender the computation

of the compensation that has been done. Accordingly, in the afternoon session, the chart in respect of 421 persons has been given. It is taken on record by marking Exhibit 'X'. Copy of the same is given to the petitioner's advocate. Now the question that would prop up is, as to whether the indemnity bonds as directed have been filed or tendered by all the petitioners or not. We therefore direct respondent no. 2 to pinpoint as to who has not tendered the indemnity bond, by way of an additional affidavit, to be filed within a period of 15 days, however, at this stage, we direct respondent no. 2 to scrutinize and whoever from list Exhibit 'X' has tendered indemnity bond, the amount in respect of them should then be released after verifying the documents as stated in the order within the aforesaid period of 15 days.

4. Place the matters for further consideration on 06/07/2026.
